

## Les verbes avec à + l'infinitif

**À** is required after certain verbs when they are followed by an **infinitive**. Note that the English translation may take an infinitive (to learn how to do something) or a gerund (to stop eating).

<b>décider (qqn) à</b>	to persuade (someone) to
<b>se décider à</b>	to decide to
<b>encourager à</b>	to encourage to
<b>s'engager à</b>	to get around to
<b>enseigner à</b>	to teach to
<b>s'habituer à</b>	to get used to
<b>hésiter à</b>	to hesitate to
<b>inviter (qqn) à</b>	to invite (someone) to
<b>se mettre à</b>	to start, set about ___-ing
<b>parvenir à</b>	to succeed in ___-ing
<b>persister à</b>	to persist in ___-ing
<b>se plaire à</b>	to take pleasure in ___-ing
<b>se préparer à</b>	to prepare oneself to
<b>recommencer à</b>	to begin ___-ing again
<b>réfléchir à</b>	to consider ___-ing
<b>renoncer à</b>	to give up ___-ing
<b>résister à</b>	to resist ___-ing

<b>réussir à</b>	to succeed in ___-ing
<b>rêver à</b>	to dream of ___-ing
